## Cambridge Area Bus Users say: restore our bus services

It is unacceptable that citi2 passengers will have no direct access to Addenbrooke's for nearly seven months and that citi1 passengers along Queen Edith's Way must first travel – in the 'wrong' direction – to the Robin Hood stop in Cherry Hinton.

Patients shouldn't have to change buses at exposed stops in cold, wet, winter weather. Will patients miss their appointments? Will hospital staff be delayed, putting patient safety at risk?

Cambridge Area Bus Users are calling upon the bus operator and the highways authority (Cambridgeshire County Council) to co-operate with the local community in finding a solution which restores our bus services.
