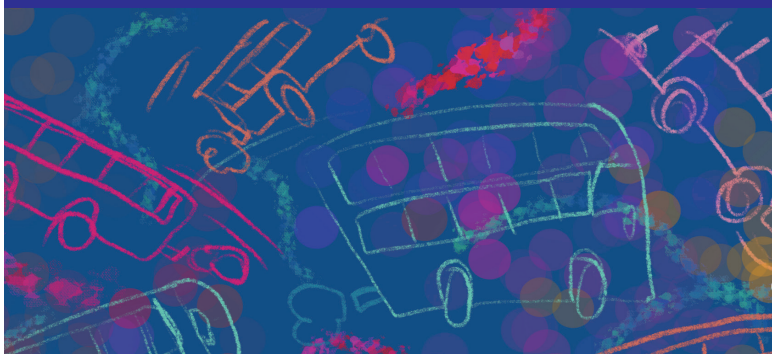

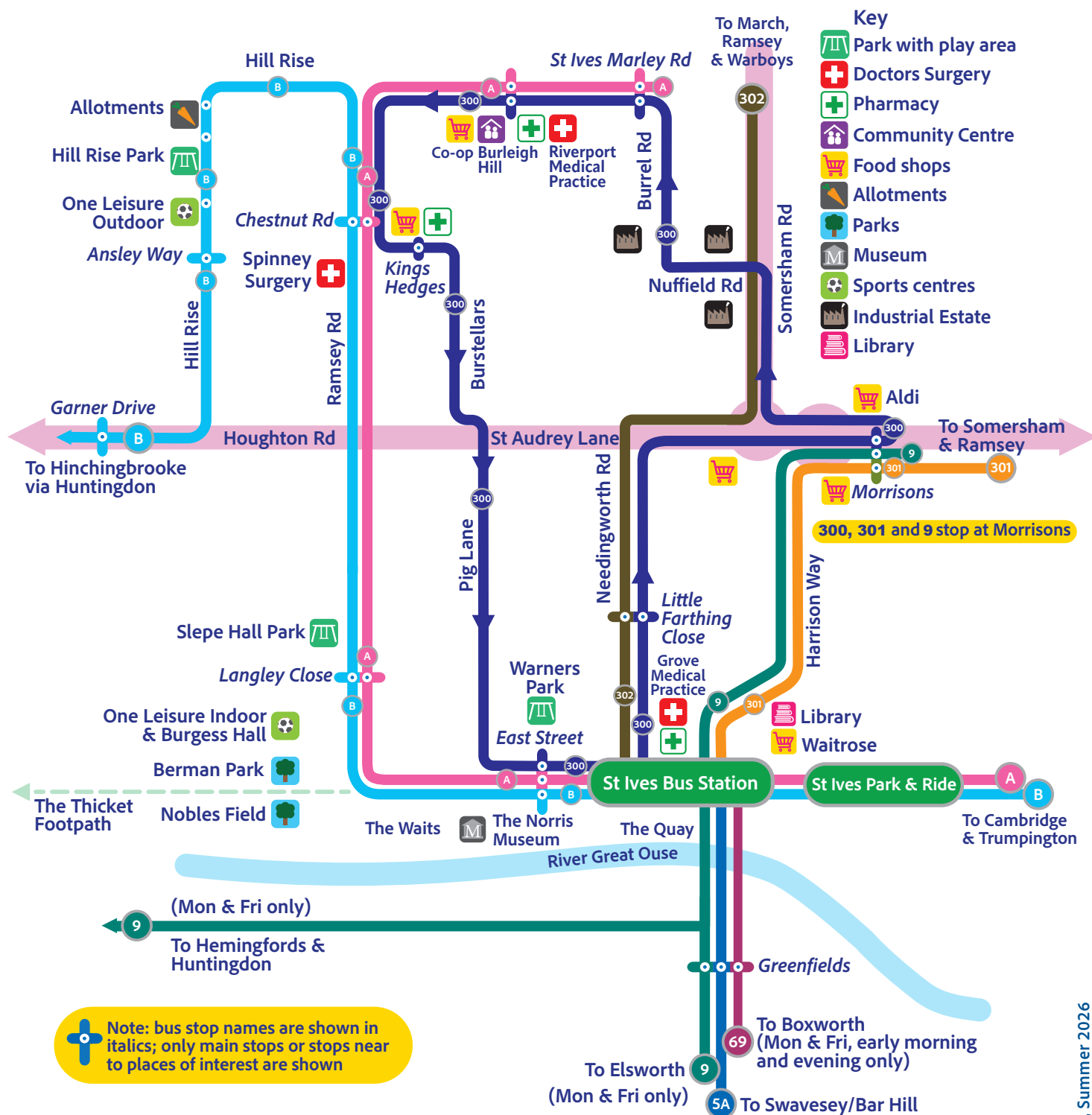

SERVICES (Stephensons of Essex)

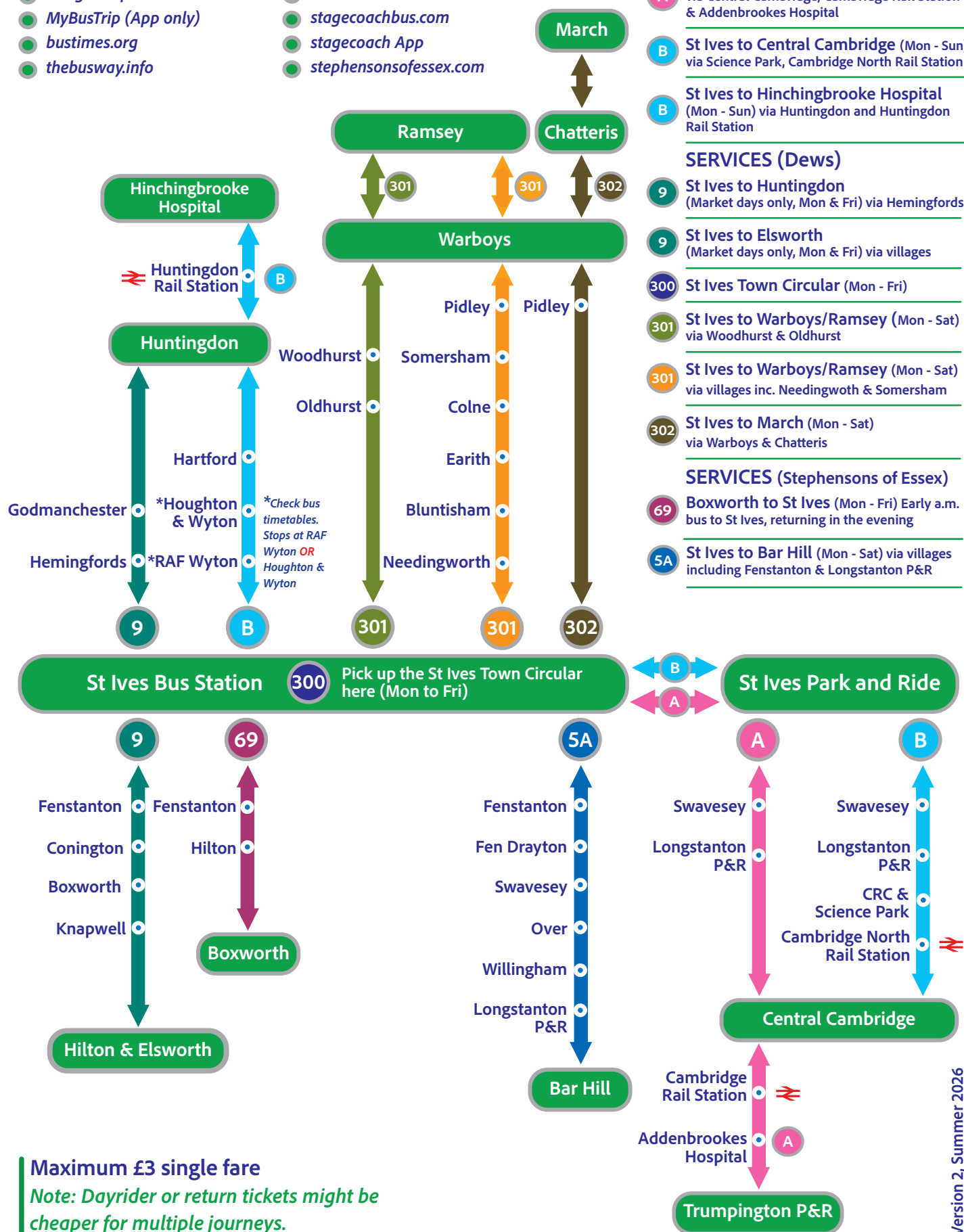
- 69** Boxworth to St Ives (Mon - Fri) Early a.m. bus to St Ives, returning in the evening
